

CVSWEB

1. Install cvsweb

```
# apt-get install cvsweb
```

2. Edit the file /etc/cvsweb/cvsweb.conf:

```
# vi /etc/cvsweb/cvsweb.conf
```

- Change the line:

```
'local'    => ['Local Repository', '/var/lib/cvs'],  
  
to
```

```
'rancid'    => ['Rancid Repository', '/var/lib/rancid/CVS'],
```

and just below add a new line:

```
'configs'   => ['Configs Repository', '/home/myusername/cvs'],  
  
(This is to show the CVS from earlier!)
```

- Save and exit

3. Open your web browser, and go to this address:

```
http://169.223.5.X/cgi-bin/cvsweb/
```

... where X is your IP address

- Notice the pulldown menu "CVS Root:". Here you can choose which repository to look at -- you should see two:

- Configs
- Rancid

- Navigate in the corresponding repository, and explore the files.
