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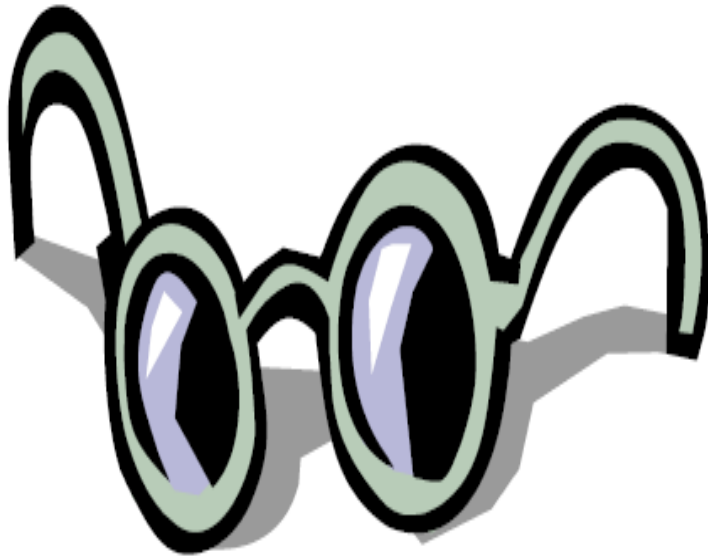
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VAK

Visual Learning Style



learn through seeing.

Visual

- What is seen
 - Body language
 - Facial expressions
- Always seats at the front.
 - Highlights key points on text for later previewing
 - Uses tape recorders to record lectures
 - Understands better by seeing
 - Diagrams, Pie-charts, Graphs
 - Video presentations
 - Illustrated text books

VAK

Auditory Learning Style



learn through listening .

Auditory

- What is heard and said.
- Written material may have less meaning until they are hard.
 - Verbal lessons
 - Taking through discussions
 - Listening to what others have to say
 - Work in study groups

VAK

Kinesthetic (Tactile) Learning Style



learn through moving, doing, and touching .

Kinesthetic

- What is felt –
 - The so called “**do-ers**”
 - Actions, Movements, Taste, Smell
- Active exploration and involvement
 - Carrying out physical activity
 - Listens to music while studying
 - Loves to get all practical and interactive
