

# IXP Manager

IXP Manager is a comprehensive management suite for Internet Exchange Points. It allows the operator of the exchange to keep track of traffic volumes, manage member subscriptions, contact details and switch port allocations.

It also allows members to see their own usage and provide details of their peering policy to other participants.

The software was developed by the Irish Internet Neutral Exchange (INEX). They describe themselves as:

INEX is a neutral, industry-owned Association, founded in 1996, that provides IP peering facilities for its members. INEX membership is open to all organisations that can benefit from peering their IP traffic. There are currently 96 members.

## Installation

The software was installed using the set of instructions that start at:

This is where the name of the exchange point and contact names are defined.

The first instance is the basic installation with a small amount of configuration to match the model we presented for IXP 1 in the workshop.
